## Key Activities of the Month:

**November 1, 2022:-** Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed attended the African Prospective leader's Summit which took place in the Capital. He remarked that pioneers from the past who exemplified Pan-Africanism in their

leadership laid the groundwork and emphasized our continent's potential to become conducive to all of its citizens will be enabled, particularly by young African leaders.

**November 2, 2022:-** Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed with First lady Zinash Tayachew and a high level delegation visited Gofa Zone. Farmers in Docha Dembela kebele have grown sesame, masho, soybeans, teff, and fruits on 80 hectares, proving how nature has blessed the region.



**On the same day:-** In Chencha woreda of Gamo zone, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed with delegation visited weaving and handicraft products that express Ethiopian's diversity. Efficient productivity in small scale farm land has been demonstrated, livestock breeding, dairy and dairy products were also included.

**November 3, 2022:-** In Arba Minch city, the national “Yelemat Tirufat” initiative was launched by Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed. This campaign focuses on both quantity and quality of honey, livestock, poultry and dairy production. This campaign will serve as a bridge between farmers, pastoralists, and consumers. And it is believed it will accelerate the journey in building a food self –sufficient country.

**November 7, 2022:-** Attending the United Nations Climate Conference #COP27, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed has discussed bilateral and regional issues with African fellow leaders on the sidelines of the conference. He boldly mentioned Ethiopia will work in solidarity on African solutions to Africa's problems and strive for a more resilient continent.

**On the same day:-** Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed held discussions with leaders of several countries on bilateral and strategic issues alongside #COP27.

**November 15, 2022 :-** Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed responded to questions

raised in a regular session of the House of People's Representatives.

**November 21, 2022:-** Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed received a delegation led by Sudan Transitional Sovereign Council member Lt. Gen Ibrahim Gaber to discuss issues of mutual concern.

**November 23, 2022:-** Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed gave a training and mission direction on Ethiopia's foreign relations policy at the African Leadership Excellence Academy. The training was attended by young and senior diplomats from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and leadership of the Ministry.

**November 29, 2022:-** At the opening ceremony of the 17th Internet Governance Forum held in Addis Ababa, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed highlighted Ethiopia’s ICT and digital transformation journey and called upon the Forum to develop “tangible, pragmatic and implementable proposals.”

**On the same day:-** He visited with an elderly woman producing outputs related to ‘*YeLemat Tirufat*’ including poultry, livestock, honey and backyard farming, who is not only fulfilling household consumption needs but also availing surplus to the community.
